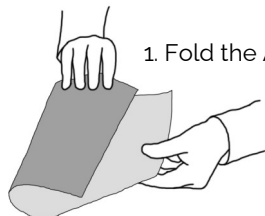


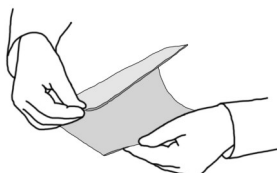

Write a short book

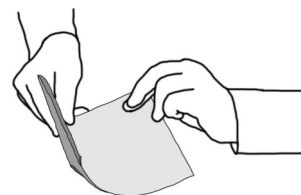
To make an eight-page book, print the following page on A4, ensuring that it is not resized when printed. The use of the cutter is, of course, to be reserved for adults...



1. Fold the A4 sheet in half (leaving the text visible).



2. Fold the sheet in half again (A6).



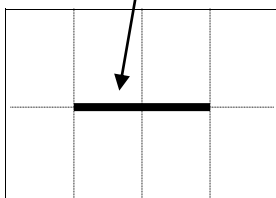
3. Carry out the third folding (A7).



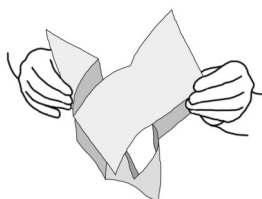
4. Ensure the precision folds.



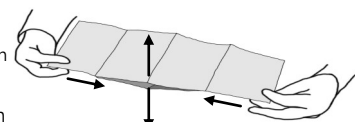
5. Cut the fold with a cutter top of the front panel.



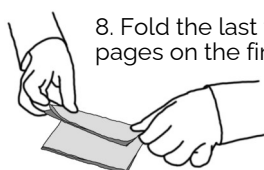
— cutting area



6. Unfold, then fold in the direction length, along from the central slot.



7. Separate them two parts power plants in bringing the ends together.



8. Fold the last two pages on the first two.
